(AMENDMENT NO 3) ORDER 2025

The City Council of Lancaster (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the County Council of Lancashire in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 33, 34, 35, 35C, and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(hereinafter called the "1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and Section 43 and Schedules 3 and 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1991(hereinafter called the "1991 Act") hereby make the following order.

1. Commencement, Citation and Revocation

- 1.1 This Order shall come into operation on [] []2025 and may be cited as "THE CITY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (Consolidation) ORDER 2023 (AMENDMENT NO 3) ORDER 2025".

2. Interpretations

- 2.1 Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

- 2.2 In this order, except where the context otherwise, requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them: -

2.2.1 "1984 Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2.2.2 "Enactment" - means any enactment, whether public, general, or local and includes any order, bylaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

- 2.3 Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or substituted by any subsequent enactment.

- 2.4 Any reference in this order to a masculine gender shall include reference to the feminine gender and neuter gender.

- 2.5 Any reference in this Order to a singular includes the plural.

- 2.6 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Amendments

- 3.1 THE CITY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (Consolidation) ORDER 2023, the Principal Order is hereby amended as follows:

- (1) The First Schedule to the Principal Order be amended to include new car parks known as "Moor Mills 4, Lancaster" and "Edward St 2, Lancaster".
The car parks to be subject to the restrictions, conditions of use and scale of charges detailed in the attached Amendment No.3 First Schedule 2025 –

Table 1 (Annex 1). Plan 36 for Moor Mill 4, Lancaster is attached (Annex 2).
Plan 37 for Edward St 2, Lancaster is attached (Annex 3)

- (2) The existing plan for Kingsway, Lancaster (Plan 23) be replaced by the revised plan as detailed in Annex 4.
- (3) The existing plan for Old Station, Morecambe (Plan 17) be replaced by the revised plan as detailed in Annex 5.
- (4) The First Schedule – Table 1 to the Principal Order be amended to introduce a loading bay and 40 minutes restriction to the area on the blue hatched box to Plan 17 (as contained in the attached Amendment No3 First Schedule 2025 (Annex 1).
- (5) The First Schedule – Table 1 to the Principal Order be amended to add a 2 hour tariff of £3.30 to the following car parks; Auction Mart, Cable St, Castle car park, Charter House, Dallas Rd, Edward St, Lodge St, Lucy St, Moor Mills (1, 2 & 3), Nelson St, Spring Garden St, Leonardsgate (Upper & lower), St Nicholas Arcade and Wood St. (as contained in the attached Amendment (No3) First Schedule 2025 (Annex 1).
- (6) Article 4(1), (3), (4) of the Principal Order is amended reference to “the seventh column” is substituted to read “the eighth column”

The First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the attached Amendment No 3 First Schedule 2025. (Annex 1)

The Prohibitions and Restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
